WHEREAS, JOHN worked closely with the NALC Legislative Department to ensure that the members of the FSALC were kept informed of legislative developments that would/could affect Letter Carriers and their families, and

WHEREAS, JOHN worked closely with the other Officers of the FSALC and the NALC To increase participation of the membership in COLCPE and E-ACTIVIST, and

WHEREAS, JOHN worked closely with our National Business Agents to ensure the best possible educational classes were made available at our Training Seminars, and

WHEREAS, JOHN was able, due to his skillful leadership, to continue to accomplish the goals and mission of the FSALC, even with declining revenue due to downsizing by the Postal Service, and

WHEREAS, JOHN served the FSALC and its members with dignity, honesty and genuine concern for Letter Carriers and their families, therefore be it

RESOLVED that the members of the Florida State Association of Letter Carriers in assembly at the 73rd Biennial Convention on this date of July 24, 2015 extend to JOHN GIORDANO the HONOR and TITLE "PRESIDENT EMERITUS of the FLORIDA STATE ASSOCIATION OF LETTER CARRIERS."
