Article 3. Section 10 of the FSALC By-laws requires that **All Branches in this Association planning to send Delegates to the Convention (State) must report the names and addresses of each elected Delegate and Alternate Delegate to the State Secretary NO LATER THAN MARCH 1ST OF THE CONVENTION YEAR. Any non-delegate who is a member of the Florida State Association of Letter Carriers may attend the training classes following the close of the Convention business session.** For the purpose of meeting this requirement, you may utilize your Official Branch Address as a common address for all Delegates. Please put names in alphabetical order by last Names.

REGISTRATION

In accordance with Article 3, Section 2 of the State By-laws, the Convention will begin at 1:00 p.m. on Thursday August 14 and end on Friday August 15 at 12:00. Beginning at 1:00 p.m. on Friday August 15 and continuing through Saturday August 16, 2025 at 5:00. Our National Business Agent and the FSALC will conduct a Training Seminar. A Registration Fee of \$50.00 has been set for FSALC Delegates and Auxiliary Members. The Thursday Family Night Dinner fee for guests, spouses and children age thirteen (13) and over is \$45.00. There will be no fee for children twelve (12) years of age and "under".

In accordance with Article 3, Section 11 of the State By-laws, **"The registration fees, as established in Article 3, Section 6 of these Bylaws, shall be paid to the FSALC Officer designated by the FSALC President not later than forty-five (45) days preceding the Convention date. Registration fees may be paid by the individual delegate or the parent Branch." THE REGISTRATION FORM(S) AND FEE(S) MUST BE RECEIVED BY JUNE 8, 2025. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS.** A copy of the Registration Form is enclosed. A Registration Form must be completed by each Delegate and/or Auxiliary Member. Make as many copies as needed.

In accordance with decisions at previous State Officers' Meetings, there will be **NO REFUNDS** for Delegates who fail to attend the Convention, except for emergencies as identified in writing, by the Branch President to the State President. The State President must be notified prior to the Convention. The request will be reviewed and acted upon by the State Executive Board at the Convention.
